Makerspace Waiver

Waiver

Please review the following conditions before using the makerspace. Acceptance to comply with these conditions is required for use of the space. ‘

1. Users must have a library card and be in good standing.
2. Users must be 14 years or older to use the makerspace. Users under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian 18 years or older who is responsible for their supervision and care while in the space.
3. All users must have a signed Makerspace waiver on file. Users between 14 and 17 must have a waiver signed by a parent or guardian on file.
4. The makerspace room and equipment is only to be used in the presence of a CLMA staff member.
5. Users will only use equipment in a safe and appropriate manner, and will notify staff if the equipment they are using is damaged or becomes unsafe during use.
6. If a tool or piece of equipment requires certification, users will not use said equipment until they have received training or certification.
7. Makerspace users agree to follow the directions of makerspace staff, and will discontinue any behaviour or use of equipment deemed unsafe by staff.
8. Users agree to report any injury resulting from equipment use to a CLMA staff member.
9. All equipment is only to be used within the confines makerspace and must be returned to staff at the end of the session.
10. Makerspace computers will only be used for digital media creation or related makerspace projects, and will not be used for unrelated activities such as browsing the internet, checking email, etc.
11. Users assume responsibility for complying with copyright and other intellectual property laws.
12. Makerspace equipment will not be used to create items or content that is:
 - a. Legally prohibited
 - b. Unsafe or harmful to the safety of others, including but not limited to weaponry
 - c. Obscene, considered hate speech, or otherwise not appropriate for a library environment
13. The library and its’ staff are not responsible for product defects, or the outcomes of individual projects produced in the space.
14. CLMA reserves the right to deny access to the makerspace or to any individual.
